STATEMENT OF FACTS

My wife and I were named in a lawsuit by Noble Mtn. Community Association in 2005. Last year, Judge _____ issued an order requiring us to pay a \$1,000 bond with each pleading filed, thus rendering us unable to defend this action. I believe this is a violation of A.R.S. 12-314 which states:

The superior court shall make no rule imposing a tax or charge upon a legal proceeding or make an allowance to any officer for services.

Clearly, the requirement that I pay \$1,000 bond for every pleading I file is nothing less than a RULE IMPOSING A CHARGE for a legal proceeding.
