Complaint as Follows:

November 4, 2007: I went to the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles for a change of address. They informed me that the State of Arizona had a "holder" on my drivers' license and I was not allowed to change my drivers' license address. They referred me to Arizona Bureau of Motor Vehicles.

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November 4, 2007: I contacted Arizona Bureau of Motor Vehicles. They referred me to , AZ Municipal Court.

November 4, 2007: I called the , AZ Municipal Court. I asked them what kind of ticket they had on me. They informed me of a DUI, December 10, 2001, registered in my name. I was unaware of any outstanding violations against me in Arizona or otherwise. They said they would "send me the proper paperwork." January or February 2008: I finally received the first correspondence from Municipal Court. It was a "Notice of Pretrial Conference" with the City Prosecutor's Office requiring in person appearance Wednesday, March 19, 2008.

I immediately called the Municipal Courts and explained to them that finances prevented me from making an in-person court appearance. I names of anyone with which I spoke—I was given department names they would send me more paperwork.

<u>May 13, 2008</u>: I requested help from the Service Coordinator of my seniors' building. Together we called the Municipal Courts for guidance to resolve these problems. <u>We followed the instructions given as follows</u>: 1) We wrote a letter to Judge

(copy enclosed dated May 29, 2008); 2) I pled not guilty to all charges; 3) I enclosed a letter from my doctor stating my health did not permit me to travel and that I am hearing impaired and illiterate in writing and reading. 4) I requested that all proceedings be done by teleconference or mail. 5) I requested free legal council be assigned. (My income was \$700 a month.)

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<u>Unknown date</u>: I received a notice of teleconference to be held July 16, 2008 <u>July 16, 2008</u>: I called . We held a Teleconference. She simply stated she would get in touch with me again.

<u>Date</u>?: Thereafter, I received two late night (9:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.) phone calls from Ms. . The first call, Ms. stated she required me to spend one day in jail. The second call, she required another document from my doctor stating I could not spend a night in jail. I told her, "To get off the case; she was no longer welcome." Date?: I received correspondence from Ms. stating a "Pretrial Sentencing" was

Date?: I received correspondence from Ms. stating a "Pretrial Sentencing" was scheduled for September 3, 2008.

September 3, 2008: As scheduled, I called for Ms. for the "Pretrial Sentencing." However, I was connected with some gentleman (who would not give his name), who said "we are doing something different. We are taking this to trial." The man then hung up and did not allow me to ask any questions. Since September 3, 2008, I have heard NOTHING by phone or mail from the AZ courts.

I have called , AZ Municipal Courts several times and was unable to get any information. I have contacted Bureau of Motor Vehicles they tell me my drivers' license are still "Held by Arizona."

I REQUEST ALL CHARGES BE DROPPED BY ARIZONA AND MY DRIVERS' LICENSE BE IMMEDIATELY REINSTATED BY THE STATE OF ARIZONA.

I trust you will assist me in correcting this matter. Thank you in advance.
