Complaint against Judge

I believe Judge _____ is discriminating against me. Whenever in his courtroom, he appeared to be making hand gestures towards me. He would roll his fingers in a manner that was a likeness to chewing his nails. I felt as though he was insulting me with this gesture. Judge _____ neglected to invite me or my ex to a telephone conference hearing and later noted, we weren't present. Judge _____ prolonged the divorce proceedings when the marriage should have been dissolved after 90 days - this has caused me undue hardships. Upon disillusionment of my marriage, a copy of the divorce decree was sent to _____. I had to request a copy.
