According to the article, Cameron's mother and Judge _____ talked about this teenager being a star-runner with a letterman's jacket. However, the fact was that he had possession of bomb making materials and it involved an aircraft.

"Who knows what he could have done or who he could have hurt".

My son, also a star-athlete with a letterman's jacket; after having a "verbal fight" with his girlfriend that led him to threaten her; was sentenced to jail with a felony, strike. He will always be tainted and haunted by this. It is unfair and unethical that people who know people in high places are able to call in a favor and influence another judge's decision making processes. So I ask you, "Don't you wish you had a Judge on your side to reduce your sentence whenever you and/or a loved one were in trouble with the law?"

Being that the commission on judicial conduct has looked at Judge _____ for his conduct as an attorney; that occurred years prior to being on the bench, it appears that Judge _____'s actions are relevant because she has been a judge prior to this article and since. It is clearly an abuse of the public trust for a judge to lend his/her name and/or title for the advancement of anyone. Certainly, one would NOT expect it in a criminal case where a heinous crime is alleged.

This unethical behavior reflects poorly not only on the judiciary system in Arizona and New Mexico but also on Oklahoma referring to _____ in the article.

In other news stories Judge _____ has clearly violated the Cannons of Ethics in prior years for hearing cases on "no car registration" when in fact her own car was not registered. This shows a pattern of habitual violations.
