Judge dismissed with prejudice a case against Magellan Health Services not good cause, I follow-
 ed procedure and timeliness. She did not choose to protect my disabled interests according to 1st contract for 3 years with Magellan. They deserve the double in this Crooked state. We are allowed \$500 per in funds per year for our contract. I received \$0 for 2 years and when my state advocate Daniel Hestline spoke on my behalf, they fought against us. I am living with dangerous and unsafe appliances (needing replacement) - they don't care. They don't recognize my contract & neither does this judge want to enforce the contract - violation of my human/civil rights state and federal. She had the authority to give us an excuse and dismissed saying it was poorly filed & non-conclusive. She is not protecting the state interests with the Magellan contract state.
 There is no justice in this horrible Crooked state. I can be hospitalized, I needed, burned by explosion, damaged by high levels of sodium (bad pressure) and my safety is threatened. I suppose she does not care about my individual rights, but does the state have all violations on Fed/state levels.
