ORDER

The complainant alleged four superior court judges failed to report a prosecutor for misconduct after he sent written notice describing the conduct to the judges. The commission found no evidence of misconduct on the part of the judges and dismissed the complaint. The evidence the complainant provided included a response from the state bar noting that an investigation found no probable cause to file formal charges against the prosecutor. The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

Dear Sirs:

Please find enclosed A copy of my recent letter to Judge _____ Judge _____ and Judge _____ Pima County Superior Court Judges who have participated in my case.

I have presented prima facie Evidence to these Judges showing Deputy County Attorney Beth Anderson engaged in A conspiracy to falsely imprison me through Fraud, Forgery, Subornation of Perjury, Fabrication of Evidence and misleading A jury.

The prosecutor has not Denied the Allegations or provided these Judges with Any sort of rebuttal evidence or claimed my handwriting expert is incorrect.

Pursuant to CANON 3 (D) (2) "A Judge having knowledge that A lawyer has committed a violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct that raises a Substantial question as to the lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as A lawyer in other respects shall inform the appropriate authority.

The letter to the judges has been filed with

the clerk of the Pima County Superior Court, A copy was also delivered to the Pima County Attorney's office by myself and the clerk of Court.

Additionally the case has been transferred to yet another Judge, one Div. 8. Pima County Superior Court on or about April 12, 2010, To date I have not received notification from any of these judges that they have performed their judicial duties by reporting the criminal acts of Prosecutor Beth Anderson.

It is my belief that Prosecutor Beth Anderson, and/or the County Attorney's office has been and continues to blackmail these judges into covering up for the crimes committed by Beth Anderson, please investigate this matter and or order the judges to comply with their duties as required under Arizona's Code of Judicial Conduct.
