everyone how terrible my husband and I are. The continued bullying
against us goes on. They are able to take the judge's ruling as proof
we are terrible people. Their false statements about us were validated
by the judge's ruling. Therefore, it is hurting our campaign and
reputation.

They continue to make ugly gestures to us while driving by our store
to make us uncomfortable when we are outside. A man in his car
drove by close enough to my husband to scare him in the village.
When I was walking in the street with my dogs and grandchildren, a
man put his thumb down to me and drove his bike very close to me to
make me uncomfortable.

Many people have told us how these people and people related to
them are told how awful we are. The judge's ruling prevented us
from having our voice heard and now we continue to be abused. His
ruling supported the continuation of the lies placed in numerous
newspapers.
