Subject: Self Report of campaign finance law violation

- Early this year I retained the service of to obtain nomination petition signatures. As
  Miles Keegan was running for Constable in the Hassayampa precinct, he decided to hire
  as well.
- 2. About April 17 2010 Mr. Keegan and I learned of an incident that involving Ms. that we determined would reflect unfavorably on us as candidates for office and we decided that it would be best to terminate our relationship with Ms.
- 3. I spoke to Ms on the phone and asked her to meet Mr. Keegan and me at the Home Depot in Surprise so that we could pay her for the work that she had done thus far.
- 4. I arrived at the meeting location after work and visited with Ms. and paid her for the signatures that she had obtained for me. At that time, I got a call from Mr. Keegan advising me that he was running late for our appointment.
- 5. I did not want to spend much more time in the company of someone I had just fired, nor did I want to delay her any more than necessary. I wrote her a check for Mr. Keegan's work from my campaign account.
- 6. Mr. Keegan arrived about 25 minutes later and wrote me a check for the same amount that I had paid Ms.
- 7. While trying to figure out which forms to use to make the proper accounting in my campaign finance report, MS. Kristi Passarelli of the Maricopa County Elections Department advised me that this is a violation. On that basis, I am reporting this incident to the Judicial Conduct Commission.
