ORDER

The complainant alleged that a justice of the peace mishandled his case, in part, by not giving him sufficient opportunity to explain the details of his claims. Based on the information provided, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct on the part of the judge. The judge acted within his authority in deciding how much detail he needed in order to rule on the case, and the remaining allegations involve legal issues outside the jurisdiction of the commission. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
