**ORDER**

The complainant alleged that a pro tem justice of the peace improperly continued her case and waived time over her objection. The commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct on the part of the judge. Court records reveal that the complainant did not object to the state's second continuance motion, and granting the motion required the court to waive time. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
