**ORDER**

The complainant alleged that a superior court judge refused to give her an opportunity to object to evidence and testify on her own behalf because she once accused him of being "paid off." After analyzing the allegations, the judge's response, and listening to the recording of the hearing in the case, the commission decided to dismiss the complaint by issuing a warning to the judge reminding him of his obligation to comply with Rule 2.6(a), which requires judges to accord to every person who has a legal interest in a proceeding the right to be heard according to law. The complaint is dismissed with comments pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23.

At a later hearing I apologized to the judge about the comment I made. I feel the judge is using this against me and it is affecting my child custody case. I attended a Review Hearing on November 2, 2010 and the first the judge asked me if I made a statement to him about accepting a bribe from \_\_\_\_\_ I admitted I did.

I do not have a copy of the audio recording for September 28, 2009 there is a minute entry available. Because of my financial situation I cannot afford the tape for the hearing on September 28, 2009, or November 2, 2010. There was no reason for the judge to bring that up a year later after an apology was given. \_\_\_\_\_ has been allowed to skip hair-folicles by \_\_\_\_\_ without repercussions. Again I believe its because of the statement I made to him. I would also like to say that I am sorry about the comment but it should not affect my court case. I feel the judge is so upset with me that any evidence I have offered to the court against \_\_\_\_\_ is not going to change his mind. Attached are police reports I recently submitted to \_\_\_\_\_ and he still left my son in \_\_\_\_\_ custody.
