This is a letter of complaint against Judge for violation, disrespect, non-informed and irrelevant questions asked during my court hearing dated October 27, 2010.

The following is a list of issues I am concerned with regarding Judge

1. Judge was 20 minutes late which in turn I was late for an appointment for my daughters

of which I took a non-paid day off having to give two weeks notice in advance.

Judge was NOT PREPARED, NOR INFORMED OR UPDATED on case.

3. Judge _ repeatedly stated I was there to plea on case. (I plead in 2009, Feb. 10). She had NO CLUE as to the status of the case.

4. Threatened me by stating I was in contempt of court when ME and THE BAD CHECK personnal tried to explain that I was not there to PLEA on my case. I plead on February 10th, 2009. PCCJC representative and I both tried to explain to her that this was NOT the reason I was in court several times. As I looked over as he was shaking his head Judge made accusations against me. She threatened she could put me in jail for contempt of court.

I was confused by her repeated statements and her lack of knowledge as to the details of the

case.

5. Irrelevant questions asked about who the two girls were sitting with me and why they were NOT in school. She asked me this twice. She was brass and addement so I explained to her that they were my adopted daughters whom had a counseling appointment immediately following the court hearing in which we ended up missing.

6. We missed our appointment due to the fact that Ms. was late to enter the courtroom and not prepared with the updated case information therefore causing a delay.

My daughters were very upset and my 10 year old was literly crying with embarrassment. My eldest asked me if I would write this letter explaining that the Judge had no right to ask about them and felt violated. She said the judge looked at her with disgust and prejudce.

I lost a days wage as I took the day off without pay for my appointments. I am still attempting to reschedule the counseling appointments as unfortunately I work and need to take another day off.
