ORDER

The complainant alleged that a municipal court judge improperly permitted an attorney to represent the opposing party despite the fact the attorney had previously represented the complainant in a materially related case and in the same court. He further alleged the judge allowed the opposing party to lie under oath.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the all of the information provided by the complainant, the response from the judge, and the recording of the hearing, the commission decided to dismiss this matter with a private warning letter to the judge. The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23(a).
