The complainant alleged that a superior court judge sexually assaulted her in a courthouse jury room and then threatened to have her killed if she did not keep quiet about it. The commission reviewed the complaint and found no evidence of ethical misconduct on the part of the judge. The complainant failed to provide any evidence to substantiate the claim, and court records do not show that she was transported to the courthouse at any time during the month she alleged the attack occurred. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
