**ORDER**

The complainant alleged that a superior court judge improperly allowed a case to proceed against him.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the complaint along with the supplemental information provided by the complainant, the members of the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

The Superior Court is aware that it has received copies of the documents attached to the present which consists of the following: A letter to where the real Blanca Alfaro who resides in Victoria Cabanas, El Salvador States has never before been to Arizona State and does not know the State, the other Charter provides that no one has the power or authorization to receive and sign some kind of document, however twelve cases have been opened with the stolen identity and these cases have been used as a business that have existed in Middle economic and immovable goods, this has violated my rights as a resident of Arizona, and my record is dirty, and so far nobody has proceeded to investigate this felony. I have much trust in the system of Justice in this country and it seems illogical to me that someone can fool the system so easily, I have given this crime in each court where cases have been deliberate and judges have omitted this information, becoming accomplices in the crime of identity theft.

I refused to believe in the complicity of the justice system in this country in crimes as theft of identity. From the 15th of this month I will begin to publish online the attached to the present letter and the proof of evidence in each case, likewise I held talks with some television media who are interested in my case to make it public knowledge.

I ask for your support to clarify this crime of identity theft and I hope that at no time this be taken as a threat, that I have always believed in justice and is the only thing I'm looking for. It is not possible a person like María Reyes (Blanca Alfaro according to stolen identity) to fool and dirty the system of Justice in this State.
