ORDER

The complainant alleged a justice of the peace ignored his case to ensure a warrant would be issued for his arrest.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant and the judge's response, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

On July 16 2012 I, _____ appeared in Consolidation Court for arraignment. I at first found it weird that the court called everyone else's name except mine. Especially because I heard the Judge and his clerk ~~specific~~ specifically say my name under his breath. He then proceeded to handle all other arraignments, only when I noticed that there was nothing left in the court room ~~except~~ except me and a party looking like they were prepping for trial did I raise my hand and ask the Judge _____ was I listed on his docket. He then replied yes and said "I have a motion to dismiss from the prosecution's office, I see no reason why I wouldn't sign it, I simply haven't gotten to it yet." I also found this quite strange seeing how the prosecution filed a motion to strike/Response to motion to dismiss. I believe there was never a motion to dismiss from the ~~prosecution~~ prosecution, and Judge _____ was attempting to purposely not call my name to give him cause to issue a bench warrant. I then received on the 18 of July 2012, a minute order saying Judge _____ having a conflict in this matter and the case was reassigned to the honorable Judge Jill Davis. I do not live in Arizona and a financial burden has been created due to another arraignment hearing. And do not see possible how Judge Davis was able to review all motion the same day she was assigned the case July 16 2012 and adequately review all case laws to deny both motions.
