ORDER

The complainant alleged that a justice of the peace engaged in improper ex parte communications, refused to consider her evidence, and exhibited an improper demeanor.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing all of the information provided by the complainant and the recording of the hearing, the commission determined that the judge did not handle the hearing. The recording demonstrated that the pro tem judge who did hear the case did not engage in ethical misconduct. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
