ORDER

The complainant alleged that a justice of the peace discriminated against him because he is a landlord.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded the judge did not violate the Code in this case. The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the judge's rulings. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

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The Judge, _____ opened the session one half hour late going on ranting about how Mohave County was cutting the budget to the Bullhead City Justice Court. He stated that three employees were laid off as a result of budget cuts. I have been trying to get Judge _____ to evict this tenant, _____ since July 22, 2012. I have gone to court on three separate eviction hearing, the last one being September 27, 2012. The Judge favors the tenant every time and throws out the eviction on some minimal excuse or technicality.

I have done several evictions in the Kingman Court without opposition from the Judge. I think this judge, _____ has some personal issues not allowing the eviction to go through.

I have wasted three days away from my dental practice and now I am forced to hire an attorney.

No rents are being paid. I have lost over \$5,000.00 dollars in rents not being paid. I have normally only rented the one bedroom in my house. I now have been locked out and can't even go into my house or master bedroom. The swimming pool is green and I have been served an injunction to stay away from my own house. The Bullhead City Code enforcement is threatening fines for weed control and unsafe water conditions in the swimming pool.

I just don't know what to do.
