**ORDER**

The complainant alleged a municipal court judge improperly threatened to hold her in contempt of court and violated her constitutional rights.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. The commission approved sending the judge a private advisory letter regarding the solicitation of supportive letters in response to a commission inquiry. The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23(a).
