ORDER

An anonymous complaint alleged a justice of the peace improperly used a photograph of himself on the bench in an election campaign advertisement.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

Rule 4.1(A)(8) of the Code of Judicial Conduct prohibits a judge from using court facilities in a campaign for judicial office. Formal Advisory Ethics Opinion 10-02 permits the use of photos of judges on the bench in campaign materials in very limited circumstances, none of which are applicable to the ad used by the judge in this case. While the judge should not have used the photo in question in his election campaign, the Scope Section of the Code contemplates that not every transgression will result in the imposition of discipline, and the commission determined that no formal discipline was warranted after considering all the facts and circumstances. The commission approved sending the judge a private warning letter concerning the restrictions contained in Rule 4.1(A)(8). The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23(a).
