## **ORDER**

The complainant alleged a justice of the peace did not afford him an opportunity to be heard in a small claims matter. The complainant misidentified the judicial officer involved. The commission added the protem justice of the peace who handled the complainant's case to its records concerning this complaint.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judges engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judges did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety as to both judges, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
