ORDER

The complainant alleged a superior court judge made improper rulings in a civil matter.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the judge's rulings. In addition, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Art Hinshaw and George H. Foster, Jr. did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

I FILED A CIVIL LAWSUIT AGAINST MY ATTORNEY WHO WAS HIRED BY ME TO DEFEND AND REPRESENT ME THROUGH MY DIVORCE PROCEEDINGS. AT A VERY IMPORTANT TRIAL DATE, "DID NOT" HAVE RECEIPTS TO SHOW OR PRESENT TO THE JUDGE WHO WAS THE JUDGE THROUGH MY DIVORCE. THIS MISREPRESENTATION COST ME OR HALF WHICH IS. THIS WAS STATED IN THE PRE-TRIAL STATEMENT THIS \$21,000 WAS GOING TO BE USED AGAINST ME BUT, STILL HE NEVER HAD RECEIPTS TO PRESENT TO THE JUDGE. RECONSIDERATIONS WERE NOW SENT TO THE JUDGE BY, BUT, WERE DENIED.
