ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge had a conflict of interest on her family law case and improperly denied her temporary custody.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if a judicial officer engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the Commission is limited to this mission.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of a judicial officer's rulings. In addition, the Commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judicial officer did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the Complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

In my mind, I assumed Judge would understand the extreme nature of the assault on me, and recognize the safety concerns I had for my son as a result. I have no legal background and, therefore, was unable to articulate the threat I felt for my safety and for the safety of my son based on a history of abuse that culminated in this final incident. My petition was denied.

days later, onmy abuser's attorney filed a motion in response to my original petitionforCustody that was denied to me. The motion was to ask the court that hebeawarded emergency temporary custody. His motion was based solely on false statements against me. I wasnever notified of a hearing, nor did I have an opportunity to address the court. Judgethe same Judgethat denied my petition and releasedfromgranted his request.This request was granted despite thefact that my abuser has beenof the abuse of a child.of the abuse of a child.

At this point, I retained legal counsel. Given the fact that Judge . with my abuser's attorney, and the fact that they are also close personal friends, my attorney filed a motion asking the Judge to recuse himself from the custody case. He granted this request and recused himself from the matter, but not the case. He will again be presiding over the matter at my abuser's next hearing.

For _________I lived with a man who has beaten me down in every way possible: physically, mentally, emotionally, verbally, economically, psychologically, even threatening to rape me- and now by manipulation of the legal system. I had tried to leave him many times, but was always coerced into going back to him because of my children. After the last attack, it was only by the grace of God that I was able to escape with my life. I expected that once I reached out for help that the judicial system would behave in a way that was fair and just. My experience has shown me that it is possible to be victimized yet again. I learned that the day I put my son into the _________ as we both held back tears, so that I could be compliant with a court order re-issued on __________ by Judge __________ who, as I stated earlier, has been recused from the custody case. I believe this Judge should have recognized that he could not be Impartial since there was a conflict of interest. My son, therefore, has suffered the consequences.

My abuser took away my power as a woman. The judicial system has now taken away my power as a Mother.
