ORDER

The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace engaged in improper demeanor and improperly disposed of the bond he posted.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

After review, the Commission found that the judge was not patient during the hearing, engaged in behavior that undermined the public confidence in the judiciary, and did not appropriately supervise her staff. While such conduct was improper under Rules 1.2, 2.8(B), and 2.12(A), the Scope Section of the Code of Judicial Conduct provides that it is not intended that every transgression will result in the imposition of discipline. The Commission decided, after considering all the facts and circumstances, to dismiss the Complaint pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23(a), but to issue a warning letter to the judge outlining her obligations under the aforementioned rules.

I had posted bond for on and was instructed not to at the fill out the bond release section if I wanted the bond returned. I had not had any correspondence with the court and when the defendent appeared he told me they said the Ames were all paid with the bond. I tried numerous times to contact the court and was told either the Judge was on Vacation or the clerk was gone or talked with another lady that said she was now and didn't know what she was doing. After numerous failed attempts I contacted and the clerk was able with the same response but she the followed up and they scheduled an Order to show Cause - No time was noted on the minute entry for the Defendent or myself on the correspondenance. When I checked in at the clerks office and they made mention Muy didn't let the defendament know the time to appear either and that if he didn't show up if I could please all the Tudge that he know the 2 time to appear.

Once in the court room the Judge, addressed the defendent, in the matter and told him it was all his tault for not letting the court know he didn't post the bond and that typically it someone else post bond after appearing the court releases the bond. The judge told the Defendent to pay back the noncy for the bond \$ on the spot or he goes to jail. The judge asked if I wanted the bond back and I replied yes then she said if I have to pay the bond Today goes to jail I ask if he could continue the payment plan with the courts and she said no that if I wanted payments that I could recie them from the defendent. I began to say in my opinion I don't feel this was handled and I was cut off and the Judg said I don't care about your opion you were rude to my staff. If you want your money he goes to Jail. I ested why the bond was posted to the fines and the Judge said they do not communica with the jail, which contradicts how they would have information to return the bond. She was extremely condescending, between herself and the clerks office they made a mistake and were not willing to connect it. I mentioned I would contact the the public Said I don't care. I asked about the papor work from the jail to the court and she said that is the Jails problem to contact them. The judge and the clerks office operate how they choose and builty their way out of their mistakes. Hearing was receased
