**RULES OF THE SUPREME COURT**

**Rule 32. Organization of State Bar of Arizona**

**(c) Membership.**

3. Admission and Fees. All persons admitted to practice in accordance with the rules of this court shall, by that fact, become active members of the state bar. Upon admission to the state bar, the applicant shall pay a fee as required by the supreme court, which shall include the annual membership fee for active members of the state bar. If an applicant is admitted to the state bar on or after July 1 in any year, the annual membership fee payable upon admission shall be reduced by one half. Upon admission to the state bar, an applicant shall also, in open court, take and subscribe an oath to support the constitution of the United States and the constitution and laws of the State of Arizona in the form provided by the supreme court. All members shall provide to the state bar office a current street address, e-mail address, telephone number, any other post office address the member may use, and the name ~~and address~~ of the bar of any other jurisdiction to which ~~he~~ the member may be admitted. Any change of ~~address~~ in this information shall be reported to the state bar within thirty days of its effective date. The state bar office shall forward to the court, on a quarterly basis, a current list of membership of the bar.
