RULES OF THE SUPREME COURT

Rule 64. Reinstatement; Eligibility

. . . .

- (f) Reinstatement After Summary Suspension by the Board of Governors; Resignation in Lieu of Reinstatement.
 - 1. [No change in text.]
- 2. Resignation in Lieu of Reinstatement. Notwithstanding the provisions of Rule 32(c)(11) of these Rules, a member who has been summarily suspended by the board may resign from membership, in lieu of seeking reinstatement. Such a resignation shall become effective when filed in the office of the state bar, accepted by the board, and approved by this court. Such resignation shall not be accepted if there is a disciplinary charge or complaint pending against the member. After the resignation is approved by this court, such person member shall be known as a "resigned member" and shall not represent to any other jurisdiction that such person member resigned while in good standing. Such a resignation shall not be a bar to the institution of subsequent discipline proceedings for any conduct of the resigned member person occurring prior to the resignation. In the event such resigned member person thereafter is disbarred, suspended or censured, the resigned member person's status shall be changed from "resigned member person" to that of a person so disciplined. A summarily suspended member who resigned in lieu of seeking reinstatement shall not be eligible for reinstatement, but may be readmitted to membership through the application procedures set forth in Rule 34 of these rules.
