

**ORDER EXTENDING EXPERIMENTAL RULES 6.9(c) AND 6.14,
LOCAL RULES OF PRACTICE, MARICOPA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT**

The Domestic Relations Committee created by this Court has filed a petition pursuant to Rule 28, Rules of the Supreme Court, seeking adoption of new family court rules (Supreme Court No. R-05-0008). An extension of experimental Rules 6.9(c) and 6.14, Maricopa County Local Rules of Practice, is necessary to allow time for the Committee's petition to be circulated for comment pursuant to Rule 28, and to be adopted by the Court. Therefore,
