ORDERED: Petition to Add Rule 8.11, Pima County Local Rules = Experimental Rule CONTINUED in effect until January 31, 2006.



**ORDER EXTENDING EXPERIMENTAL RULE 8,
LOCAL RULES OF PRACTICE, PIMA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT**

The Domestic Relations Committee created by this Court has filed a petition pursuant to Rule 28, Rules of the Supreme Court, seeking adoption of new family court rules (Supreme Court No. R-05-0008). An extension of experimental Rule 8, Pima County Local Rules of Practice, is necessary to allow time for the Committee's petition to be circulated for comment pursuant to Rule 28, and to be adopted by the Court.
