This matter having come on for hearing before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona, it having duly rendered its decision and there having been no discretionary review and sua sponte review having been declined by the Court,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that **THOMAS C. PICCIOLI**, a suspended member of the State Bar of Arizona, is hereby suspended from the practice of law for a period of two (2) years and six (6) months, effective June 16, 2003, for conduct in violation of his duties and obligations as a lawyer, as disclosed in the Disciplinary Commission Report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **THOMAS C. PICCIOLI** shall be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years upon reinstatement. The terms of probation will be determined at the time of reinstatement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall comply with all rule provisions regarding reinstatement proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall be assessed costs and expenses of the disciplinary proceedings as provided in Rule 60(b).
