ESTABLISHING LENGTH OF TERMS FOR THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION) Administrative Order No. 2000 - 05 (Revising Administrative Order No. 91-30)

On October 29, 1991, by Administrative Order No. 91-30, the Supreme Court established policies governing the Alternative Dispute Resolution Fund, including the Advisory Committee to advise on Alternative Dispute Resolution program administration.

Term lengths for chair and members are limited to one year. However it is determined that best practice for continuity and quality of the Committee would be to stagger term limits for lengths of one, two, and three years. After due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 91-30 shall be amended to delete the provision under section C.8 indicating a one year length of term for chair and members and to include the following provision under section C.8 to address the length of terms for chair and members: "Members and chair of the committee shall be appointed at the pleasure of the Chief Justice to serve terms of varying lengths to encourage continuity of the committee, not to exceed three years."
