

Pursuant to Rule 8.4 (c) of the Rules of Criminal Procedure the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Coconino County, Fred Newton has applied for suspension of the application of Rule 8 of the Rules of Criminal Procedure to the pending case of Arizona v. Magee, Coconino Cause No. CR2001-1042 to allow the trial in this matter to commence on April 3, 2002 rather than April 1, 2002 as would be required under the rules. It appears that the requested suspension of the rules is required by extraordinary circumstances and congestion of the court calendar that prevent the trial in this case from the beginning within the period required by the rules.

Now therefore, in accordance with Rule 8.4 (c) of the Rules of Criminal Procedure,

IT IS ORDERED that the requirements of Rule 8 of the Rules of Criminal Procedure are suspended in the case of Arizona v. Magee, Coconino Cause No. CR2001-1042 to allow the trial in this matter to commence on April 3, 2002.
