Pursuant to Rule 82, Rules of the Supreme Court, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing certain members of the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee. Members of the Committee shall serve three-year terms; terms shall be staggered as designated by the Chief Justice; and no member shall serve for more than two consecutive terms. Members shall continue to serve until a successor is appointed, and appointments to fill a vacancy shall be for the balance of the terms.

On February 26, 2001, by Administrative Order 2001-30, the Honorable James B. Sult was appointed as one of the Court of Appeals, Division One, members on the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee to fulfill the vacancy left by the Honorable Rebecca Berch. This Court is advised that the Honorable James B. Sult has resigned from the Committee leaving a vacancy for the remainder of the term ending on April 30, 2003. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Sheldon H. Weisberg is appointed to the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee to serve as a Court of Appeals, Division One, member for a term beginning upon entry of this Order and ending April 30, 2003.
