Administrative Order No. 2002-<u>99</u>

Pursuant to Laws 1995, Chapter 257, establishing the Community Notification Guidelines Committee, which was repealed by Laws 1996, Chapter 315, the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court is authorized to appoint two adult probation officers or their designees, one of whom represents a county with a population of more than 400,000 persons, and one of whom represents a county with a population of 400,000 persons or less, according to the most recent United States decennial census.

Laws 1997, Chapter 136, §§ 26, 44 and 45, established that appointed members to the Committee will serve a two-year term and the appropriate appointing authority shall make all subsequent appointments as prescribed by statute. Therefore, after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the individuals named below are appointed to serve as members of the Community Notification Guidelines Committee beginning upon entry of this Order and ending August 15, 2004.
