Pursuant to Rules of the Supreme Court, 31(d)(8), the State Bar Board should cause to have performed periodic audits of the Client Protection Fund. The Court requires the State Bar and the Client Protection Fund to perform regular audits on the State Bar and Client Protection Fund as part of normal fiduciary responsibilities. Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the State Bar Client Protection Fund and staff are authorized to provide any information required by auditing staff to conduct a thorough and complete audit on the Client Protection Fund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all personal identifying information pertaining to individual claims received by auditing staff shall be kept confidential.
