Administrative Order No. 2005 -09

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County has requested the assignment of a judge of the Arizona Court of Appeals to serve in that court for the purpose of enhancing the court's ability to process criminal court matters. Therefore, pursuant to Article 6, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that, in addition to his regular duties as a judge of Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals, the Honorable Patrick Irvine is assigned for a period beginning upon signature of this Order and ending August 31, 2005, to serve as a judge in the Superior Court in Maricopa County in matters designated by the presiding judge. While serving as a judge in the designated matters, Judge Irvine shall have all of the powers and duties of a superior court judge. These powers and duties shall extend beyond the period of this assignment for the purpose of hearing and determining any proceeding necessary to a final determination of a cause heard in whole or in part during the period of this assignment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this assignment is conditioned upon the agreement by Judge Irvine to serve in the Superior Court for any matters designated and to do so for no additional compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise.
