While serving as a judge in the designated matter, Judge Carmine Cornelio shall have all of the powers and duties of a judge of the Court of Appeals. These powers and duties shall extend beyond the period of this assignment for the purpose of hearing and determining any proceeding necessary to a final determination of a cause heard in whole or in part during the period of this assignment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this assignment is conditioned upon the agreement by Judge Carmine Cornelio to serve in Division Two of the Arizona Court of Appeals for the designated matter and to do so for no additional compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise.
