

ORDER DESIGNATING THE COMMITTEE ON CRIMINAL PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE OF THE STATE BAR OF ARIZONA AS AN ADVISORY BOARD TO THIS COURT TO REVIEW AND RECOMMEND REVISION OF THE RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE FOR THE SUPERIOR COURTS OF ARIZONA

Pursuant to Article 6, § 5, Arizona Constitution, and A.R.S. §§ 12-109 and 12-110, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Committee on Criminal Practice and Procedure of the State Bar of Arizona shall, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-110, act as an Advisory Board to this Court, to review the Rules of Criminal Procedure of the Superior Courts of Arizona, 17 A.R.S., and report to this Court its recommendations for revision and amendment of all of said rules.

2. That the said Advisory Board consider all available source material, including but not limited to the decisions of the Courts of the State of Arizona, existing rules and statutes of the State of Arizona, the approved drafts of the American Bar Association Standards of Criminal Justice, the decisions of the United States Supreme Court, Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, and publications of the American Law Institute.

3. That the Advisory Board report to this Court from time to time as to its progress and tentative conclusions, and that it complete its review and recommendations not later than March 1, 1971.
