ORDER AMENDING PARAGRAPH "J" OF THE STANDARDS FOR
SUPERIOR COURT ADMINISTRATION - ADULT PROBATION OFFICERS.


IT IS ORDERED that Paragraph "J" of "Standards for Superior Court Administration - Adult Probation Officers (73-1 TR-ADM-PROB)", be, and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"J. Effective date of standards.

These standards shall be effective March 1, 1973. Any person serving as a chief adult probation officer, adult probation officer or deputy adult probation officer for a period of 1 year prior to March 1, 1973 shall be deemed to possess the qualifications required by these standards."

Annexed to this order is a new page 6, R.3-9-73 to replace the original page 6 of the "Standards for Superior Court Administration - Adult Probation Officers (73-1 TR-ADM-PROB)".

8. Supply such information as may be requested by the department of corrections for its statistical reporting system.

9. Perform such other duties as may be assigned by the presiding judge of the superior court.

J. Effective date of standards.

These standards shall be effective March 1, 1973. Any person serving as a chief adult probation officer, adult probation officer or deputy adult probation officer for a period of 1 year prior to March 1, 1973 shall be deemed to possess the qualifications required by these standards.
