ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

In order to promote more efficient administration in and of the Justice of the Peace Courts in each of the Counties of this State and, pursuant to Article 6, Sections 3 and 11, Constitution of Arizona, as amended,

IT IS ORDERED that the administrative supervision over the Justice of the Peace Courts in the respective Counties by the Supreme Court, as exercised through the Chief Justice, is hereby delegated to the Presiding Judges of the Superior Court in the respective Counties in which each has been appointed,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such administrative authority as it relates and is applicable to Justice of the Peace Courts shall include, but is not limited to, the powers and authority set forth in Rule I, Rules of Practice of the Superior Court of Arizona.
