

APPOINTMENT OF A SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO PREPARE RULES OF PROCEDURE IN TRAFFIC CASES

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 83-5

The Arizona Legislature has recently enacted legislation providing for classification of certain criminal traffic offenses as civil traffic violations. Chapter 271, Laws of 1983. This action by the Legislature requires that the Rules of Procedure in Traffic Cases, 17A A.R.S., be revised.

Pursuant to Article VI Section 5(5) of the Arizona Constitution the hereinafter named individuals are appointed members of a special committee to study and recommend to this court rules of procedure in traffic cases, especially rules of procedure in civil traffic violation cases. The committee shall also study and recommend a uniform traffic ticket and complaint form for use in traffic cases including civil traffic violation cases.
