
SUPREME COURT OF ARIZONA

APPOINTMENT OF A TEMPORARY MEMBER FOR THE COMMITTEE ON EXAMINATIONS

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 84-2

Good cause appearing, it is

ORDERED that William E. Platt, Jr., of Coolidge, Arizona, is relieved as a member of the Committee on Examinations from all responsibilities in connection with the February 1984 Bar examination.

FURTHER ORDERED that Tom Slutes of Tucson, Arizona, is appointed a member of the Committee on Examinations for the limited purpose of taking the place of William E. Platt, Jr. in preparing, conducting, grading and reviewing the February 1984 Bar examination, and that upon the completion of the foregoing task Tom Slutes is relieved of further responsibility on the Committee on Examinations.

FURTHER ORDERED that William E. Platt, Jr. shall continue to be a member of the Committee on Examinations and actively participate in the activities of that committee except as to any and all matters connected with the February 1984 Bar examination.
