ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
NO. 84-7

In accordance with Rule 27(c), Rules of the Supreme Court, the Board of Governors of the State Bar having requested the approval of the Court for an increase in the annual membership fees for active and retired members of the State Bar commencing with the year 1985, and after consideration of the matters submitted by the Board of Governors in support of the request, now therefore, it is

ORDERED that the request of the Board of Governors is granted as modified herein, and commencing January 1, 1985, the annual membership fee for active and retired members of the State Bar shall be:

- Retired Members \$50 per year
- Active Members in practice less than two years \$150 per year
- Active Members in practice two or more years \$210 per year

The above stated annual membership fees include \$10 as the amount for the funding of the Clients' Security Fund, and such amount shall be stated and accounted for separately.
