Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 84-7 dated October 1, 1984, the annual membership fee for membership in the State Bar of Arizona was established for 1985. One of the categories of membership under the current rules of this court is that of "retired member", but the classification of retired member is to be changed to "inactive member" effective February 1, 1985, pursuant to the order amending the Rules of the Supreme Court dated September 7, 1984. In view of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that the annual membership fee for inactive members of the State Bar of Arizona commencing February 1, 1985 shall be \$50 per year, and \$10 of such fee shall be stated and accounted for separately and placed in the Clients' Security Fund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that retired members who have paid the annual membership fee for their classification prior to February 1, 1985 shall be deemed to have satisfied the membership fee requirement for inactive members for the year 1985.
