ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 84-14

The enactment into law of A.R.S. § 22-125 in 1981 regarding compensation of justices of the peace caused the Administrative Office of the Courts, with the oral approval of this Court, to compile and transmit certain case filing statistical reports to county boards of supervisors so that the compensation of justices of the peace could be computed. This Court now formally approves all such past reports transmitted to boards of supervisors and finds it desirable to establish as a matter of record that future reports shall be in accord with this order and the form attached to this order as Exhibit 1.

THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority granted this Court by Article VI, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution, this order is made for the purpose of establishing the statistical filing data to be submitted to county boards of supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-125.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

 In addition to any other statistical reporting requirements established by the Administrative Director of the Courts on behalf of the Supreme Court, each justice of the peace shall, at a minimum, report to the Administrative Office of the Courts the following monthly statistical filing data on a form as determined by the Administrative Director:

- a) Civil actions, pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-201B and § 22-503, when the amount involved is less than two thousand five hundred dollars.
- b) Civil actions, pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-201C and D, for forcible entry and detainer and right to possession of real property.
- c) Traffic complaints alleging a violation of A.R.S. §§ 28-662 through 28-664, 28-692, 28-693, and 28-708.
- d) All other traffic complaints whether criminal or civil including misdemeanor violations of the Arizona Corporation Commission's motor carrier regulations and misdemeanor violations of the "Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility" statutes, A.R.S. §§ 28-1251 through 28-1260.
- e) Other complaints, not otherwise classified above, alleging a misdemeanor violation including failure to appear complaints.
- f) Complaints alleging a felony for purposes of holding a preliminary hearing.
- 2. The Administrative Director shall compile the foregoing statistics on a calendar year basis for all justice

courts in each county and shall transmit the statistics each year to the respective county board of supervisors.
