In order to provide a more coordinated education program for the integrated judicial department of the State of Arizona, and in accordance with the administrative authority vested in the Supreme Court by Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the 1987 Annual Conference for Limited Jurisdiction Judges be held at the Sheraton El Conquistador Hotel in Tucson, November 2, 3, and 4, and that the 1987 Annual Judicial Conference for Appellate and Superior Court Judges be held at the same location on November 4, 5, and 6. This order combines the two judicial conferences into a weeklong period of judicial education activities. Programs unique to limited jurisdiction judges will be conducted at the beginning of the week; programs unique to appellate and superior court judges will be conducted at the end of the week. Wednesday, November 4, will be a transition day during which programs will be conducted for judges from all courts.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that excuse from attendance at the combined conference shall be granted only by the Chief Justice upon a showing of good cause.
