


SUPREME COURT OF ARIZONA

ASSUMPTION OF EXISTING COMMITTEES BY THE
COUNCIL ON JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION

Administrative Order No. 87-18



In accordance with Administrative Order 87-17, the Chief Justice may appoint standing or advisory committees of the Council on Judicial Administration to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities. The committees may be new committees, created expressly for the Council, or existing Supreme Court committees, the responsibilities of which will be assumed by the Council. Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Committee on Standards for the Defense of Indigents created by Administrative Order No. 86-13 on December 2, 1986, and expanded by Administrative Order No. 87-16, on May 13, 1987, shall be an advisory committee of the Council and shall be known as the Committee on Standards for the Defense of Indigents. All existing members of the former committee shall be members of the advisory committee. The chairman of the advisory committee shall be Frederick J. Dardis.
2. The Special Committee to Prepare a Handbook for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction created by Administrative Order No. 86-4 on June 19, 1986, shall be an advisory committee of the Council and shall be known as the Committee on Procedures for Limited Jurisdiction Courts. All existing members of the former committee are now members of the advisory committee. The chairman of the advisory committee shall be Sidney F. Mitchell.
3. The Committee on Child Support Guidelines created on March 12, 1987, shall be an advisory committee of the Council and shall be known as the Committee on Child Support Guidelines. All existing members of the former committee are now members of the advisory committee. The chairman of the advisory committee shall be Richard K. Mangum. This committee shall terminate upon submission of its report to the Council on June 3, 1987.

4. The Committee on Juvenile Court Judges shall be a standing committee of the Council and shall be known as the Committee on Juvenile Courts. All juvenile court judges shall be members of the standing committee. The chairman of the advisory committee shall be the Chief Justice or his designee.

5. These changes shall become effective on June 1, 1987.
