

Administrative Order No. 87-19

Amendment to Administrative Order No. 87-18

Prior to the creation of the Council on Judicial Administration's Committee on Juvenile Courts, the then existing Committee of Juvenile Court Judges included juvenile judges pro tempore, juvenile court commissioners and juvenile court referees as non-voting members. These members were not included on the new committee. The Committee on Juvenile Courts has now recommended that additional members be added. Therefore, paragraph 4 of Administrative Order No. 87-18, pertaining to the assumption of existing committees by the Council on Judicial Administration, dated May 20, 1987, is amended as follows:

4. The Committee on Juvenile Court Judges shall be a standing committee of the Council and shall be known as the Committee on Juvenile Courts. The voting members of the committee shall be all the Juvenile Court Judges. The non-voting members of the committee shall be juvenile judges pro tempore, juvenile court commissioners, and juvenile court referees. The chairman of the committee shall be the Chief Justice or his designee. The Chief Justice or his designee shall appoint three directors of Juvenile Court Services to be members of this committee.
