


SUPREME COURT OF ARIZONA



ORDER AUTHORIZING CLERK OF COURT
TO SIGN COURT ORDERS

Administrative Order No. 87-24

The Court having given consideration to the matter of the authority of the Clerk of the Supreme Court to sign orders of the Court,

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk is hereby authorized to sign the following orders:

1. Referring Miscellaneous Special Actions to Attorney General and/or County Attorney for Response; Setting Due Dates for Response and Reply; Setting Date for Consideration by the Court; Waiving Filing Fee
2. Continuing Special Action Hearings
3. Granting Extended Pagination (Briefs and Memoranda)
4. Granting First Extension on Briefs and Other Pleadings
5. Granting Second Extension on Briefs and Other Pleadings Where Good Cause is Shown (if Clerk believes that motion should be denied outright or that less time than that sought should be permitted, matter will be referred to Chief Justice)
6. Releasing Reporter's Transcripts to Judge of Superior Court, Clerk of Superior Court, or Court Reporter
7. Granting Extension of Time for Return of Reporter's Transcripts

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk is given authority to sign the following orders in connection with criminal appeals:

8. Denying Defense Counsel's Motion to Withdraw (Anders cases) and Permitting Both Appellant and Appellee to file Supplemental Briefs
9. Granting Oral Argument Upon Request of Either Party

10. When Oral Argument Not Requested, Submitting Matter
on the Briefs
