Administrative Order No. 87-33

In accordance with recently enacted House Bill 2202 on drug crimes, the Arizona Supreme Court has been authorized to develop a plan on drug-testing for adults and juveniles charged with public offenses. Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that a Committee on Drug Testing is hereby created to advise the Council on Judicial Administration on the requirements of a drug-testing plan and to assist the Council in preparing a recommended plan for submission to the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following persons are appointed to the Committee on Drug Testing beginning August 1, 1987, to serve until completion of a drug-testing plan.
