

Administrative Order No. 88-7

In accordance with Administrative Order 87-17, the Chief Justice may establish advisory committees to the Council on Judicial Administration to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities. Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. An advisory committee on rules is hereby established as a committee to the Council on Judicial Administration and shall be known as the Committee on Rules.
2. The purposes of this committee is to review existing rules, consider new rules, and to recommend changes in existing rules or recommend the adoption of new rules.
3. Committee leadership and members of the committee shall be appointed by the Chief Justice.
